One is supply. Japan provides Ukraine drones, helmets, clothes, food, lights, binoculars, generators, and a lot of money.



It is important to send food, water, daily necessities and hygiene items. Third is volunteering. Relief supplies distribution, interpretation, and teaching about life in Japan.

GLOBAL COMMODITY PRICES

The price of items has been rising recently. In December 2022, Japan commodity prices for the consumer were 4% higher than last month. CURRENT STATE OF COVID-19



TURKEY EARTHQUAKE

At 4:17 am on Monday February 6, 2023, an earthquake centered near Syria in southeastern Turkey destroyed more than 1,700 buildings in southeastern Turkey and northwestern Syria. Its magnitude was 7.6. It was larger than M7.3 of the Great Hanshin Earthquake. So far, more than 28,000 people have died.

Rescue activities are continuing in the affected areas, and on February 11, a 5-year-old girl was rescued from a destroyed building in southern Turkey, and a 7-month-old baby was rescued in Hatay. Furthermore, security is getting worse.

A German rescue team official said, "There is a shortage of water and food, and all kinds of stores, including supermarkets, have been destroyed. We will resume our activities as soon as it is safe to do so."

In addition to Western countries, China, Russia, and Ukraine have also started support activities. Nearly a week has passed since the earthquake, and rescue operations are continuing under difficult conditions.

What we can do now is to know the local situation. Also, participating in fund-raising activities such as UNICEF is a great help.
